We are delighted to greet you this summer! As summer will soon give way to fall, we are thrilled to welcome you back to the Hamilton Murray Theater for Theatre Intime's upcoming 2023-2024 season.

Since its first performance in 1920, Theatre Intime has offered young artists at Princeton the opportunity to independently produce high-quality works of theatre, gain hands-on practical experience and develop their artistic voices and techne—a mission that has served the student body for over a century. We hope that you will join us this year for yet another season of thrilling performances.

The 2023-2024 season encapsulates the power and beauty of storytelling, exploring love, change, and community. We open with Dario Fo's *Low Pay Don't Pay*, a timely Marxist farce, focusing on the friendship of two housewives amidst skyrocketing grocery prices. Next, an original work about the trials of love and change by Matthew Cooperberg ('26) and Orion Lopez-Ramirez ('25), *All the Things They Wish They Said*. We begin 2024 with the hilarious Shakespearean musical *Something Rotten!*, then move to Domonique Morriseau's *Pipeline*, a potent drama of a rigged education system and a mother's love. We shift to Spring with *Yaga* by Kat Sandler, a feminist murder mystery steeped in folklore. Finally, we close with the musical *Pippin*, a show brimming with spectacle that questions what it means to live.

We welcome back all of our traditional festivals to the stage this season. Among these are Play in a Day, our Freshman One-Act Festival, and our Student Playwrights Festival, as well as our Fall Cultural Festival highlighting underrepresented voices in theatre and the performing arts. Additionally, we welcome a new one this season, as our Shakespeare Festival will debut come February. We're looking forward to sharing this fantastic season with you, filled to the brim with joy, inspiration, and insights from the lived experiences of our brilliant and imaginative artists. 


